Senior Project Options



Four Options

1. Internship
2. EVIT
3. Alternative Research Project
4. Job / Employment



Internship

All senior students must complete an internship or senior project. Students in an EVIT program can work with their Principal about using their EVIT coursework to satisfy the internship requirement.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 40 Hours of documented internship
- The employability course will count towards two of their hours
- Internship will be in an area of interest
- Presentation at the end of the year





EVIT or FHHS CTE Program

Our EVIT students have the availability to use their CTE program for their Senior Project with approval from the Principal. Our Sports Medicine students have the opportunity to use their program in Sports Med II or III. **(senior year only)**

REQUIREMENTS:

- Students will complete an employability skills course to be turned in electronically
- Verification of EVIT enrollment and completion
- Presentation at the end of the year





Alternative Research Project

- Projects will be approved as needed by Administrators
- Minimum of 40 hours
- Students will be given specific prompts to complete a research project on their target position or how they can support their community
- Completion of Employability Skills Course
- Employability Skills will be utilized in the research and presentation
- Presentation at the end of the year





Job / Employment

Employment will be an option on an as needed basis and by Principal approval only. Some Students are already employed as a necessity. We do not want this to create an undue burden on those students who are already developing skills.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum of 40 hours on the job
- Complete employability skills course online
- Paycheck or proof of employment
- Interview the employer about the profession.
- Presentation at the end of the year or term

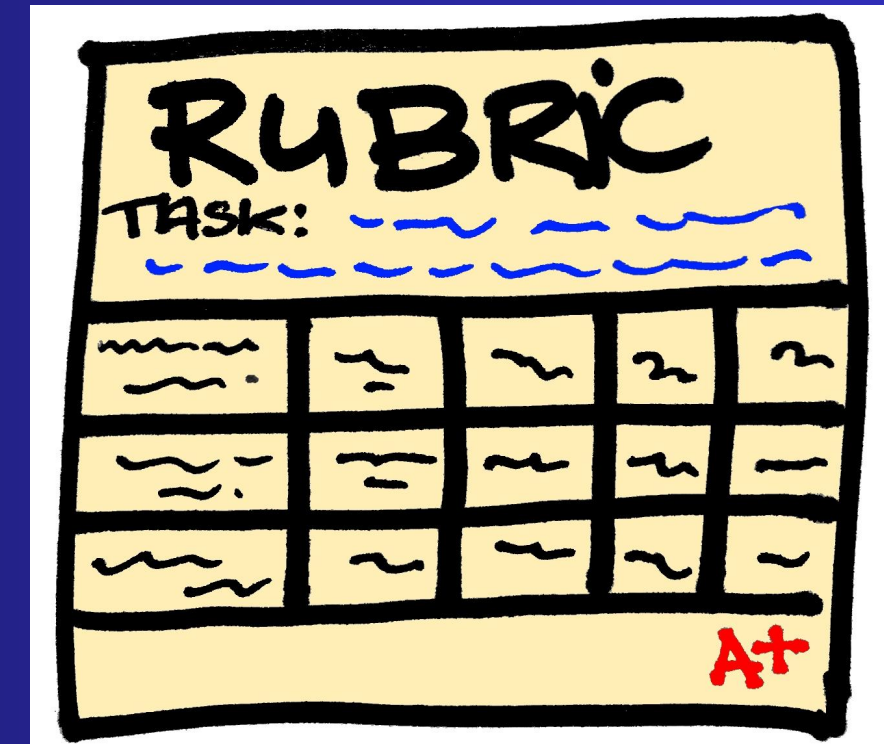
Student Advisory

 - Include Checklist of Requirements
- Facilitate Employability Skills Course
- Make sure students are ready to give the presentation to the panel at the end of the term/year.
- Advisor will be on the panel for their advisory students
